New water filtration and recycling system to be installed at the renovated swimming pool on Chennai Marina Beach at a cost of Rs. 3 crore 41 lakh

## **Chennai Water Board Information**

A new water filtration and recycling system with a capacity of 4.5 MLD will be installed by the Chennai Water Board at a cost of Rs. 3 crore 41 lakh in the renovated swimming pool on Chennai Marina Beach.

This swimming pool was established in 1942 during the Second World War on Chennai Marina Beach. It was then handed over to the Chennai Municipal Corporation in 1947 and has been maintained by the Greater Chennai Corporation for the past 77 years.

The swimming pool was renovated at a cost of Rs. 1 crore 37 lakh and opened by the Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister Thiru. Udayanidhi Stalin on 08.10.2024 in the presence of the Hon'ble Minister of Municipal Administration Thiru. K. N. Nehru and is in use.

In this situation, the existing water filtration and recycling facilities in this swimming pool were installed 20 years ago. Considering the need to improve these facilities in the current situation, the Chennai Water Board has taken steps to install a water filtration and recycling system with modern facilities as per the order of the Hon'ble Minister of Municipal Administration.

Accordingly, after installing a water filtration and recycling system with a capacity of 4.5 MLD in this swimming pool at an estimated cost of Rs. 3 crore 41 lakh, the Chennai Water Board will undertake the work of operating and maintaining it for 5 years.
