On behalf of Chennai Drinking Water Board, the new testing laboratory operating in Kilpauk has received national accreditation from the National Accreditation Board For Testing And Calibration Laboratories (NABL).

Chennai Drinking Water Board Information

On behalf of Chennai Drinking Water Board, a new testing laboratory has been set up in Kilpauk at an estimated cost of Rs. 7.05 crores to test the quality of drinking water and wastewater in a modern manner. Chennai Drinking Water Board, in addition to providing quality drinking water and safely disposing of wastewater, is also carrying out testing of drinking water quality as an integrated task. This laboratory is working with skilled water analysts using modern technology and equipment.

In this laboratory, water used for drinking water and construction purposes is tested as per IS10500: 2012 & IS456: 2000 standards respectively. Currently, this laboratory has received national accreditation from the National Accreditation Board For Testing And Calibration Laboratories (NABL).

Furthermore, the wastewater samples treated through sewage treatment structures in apartments and commercial complexes are tested as per the standards of the Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board before being mixed into the sewage systems of the Chennai Drinking Water Board.

Therefore, the public and construction companies can benefit from testing their homes, commercial use, drinking water used in apartments, the quality of wells and borehole water in homes, water samples for construction needs and treated wastewater samples in this modern laboratory.
